Promise for the Future scholarship program, the **student must:** (links are highlighted in red)

- Begin the fall semester after high school graduation
- Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.gov
- Complete and submit the online [CAC Scholarship application](#)
- Upload an unofficial copy of high school transcript onto student's [CAC student portal](#)
- Enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
- Pursue a CAC degree or certificate program
