Dear Parent/Guardian,

Maricopa Unified School District is committed to ensuring all students become skillful readers and writers. In order to help your child to meet AZ Move On When Reading requirements, K-3 students will be screened in the fall, winter, and spring to monitor progress and identify areas where your child may need additional support. Should your child need intervention support, an initial plan will be communicated with you as well as ongoing updates on your child's progress throughout the year.

Move On When Reading legislation, A.R.S. 15-701 states that if a student scores below the cut score on the reading portion of the 3rd-grade statewide exam, the student will not be promoted to the 4th grade until the student makes sufficient progress toward proficiency.
