

Maricopa Unified School District School Year Opening 2021-22 COVID-19 Mitigation Strategies

In this legislative session, a bill was passed that prohibits Arizona school districts from requiring students or staff to wear masks during school hours and on district property. Schools are also prohibited from requiring vaccines or masks to participate in in-person instruction.

Personal Protective Equipment	 Masks are optional indoors and outdoors. All employees, students, and visitors who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear face coverings, but it is <i>not required</i>. PPE will continue to be available to students and staff who request them. Individual bottles and hand sanitizer stations will continue to be available on all campuses 	Continue to follow state legislation regarding mask enforcement
Supplies/Materials	Sharing of materials allowable with hand hygiene mitigations in place	Restricted sharing of supplies and materials
Cafeteria Operations	 Returning to as close to normal as possible, with 3 ft distancing when feasible. Handwashing before meals. 	Consider revising
Buildings and Buses	 Large group gatherings Observe 3 ft. social distancing where feasible Transportation schedule to return to pre-COVID arrivals/departures 	Follow state legislation regarding group gatherings District may adjust arrival departure times
