Dear MUSD Parents:

After careful review of COVID-19 benchmark data, and guidelines from local and federal health agencies, the **MUSD Governing Board voted to modify MUSD mask protocols**. The updated protocols are listed below:

April 29- May 27

## **Indoors - REQUIRED**

- Masks are required in school and district buildings and on school buses

## **Outdoors - OPTIONAL**

- \*Masks are recommended but not required outdoors (\*Masks are still required at AIA athletic events)

June 1 - Summer School

## **Indoors -OPTIONAL**

- Masks are recommended in school and district buildings and on school buses but not required

We will continue to monitor case counts throughout the district and respond to ensure the safety of our students and employees. Should case counts increase significantly, MUSD may reinstate mask requirements.

All other mitigation strategies including physical distancing, frequent handwashing, and cleaning routines will remain in place. Following mitigation strategies permitted MUSD to open schools last fall, reduce the number of quarantines, plan in-person celebrations, and begin to address mask usage. With your help, we are able to finish the school year strong.
