Dear MUSD Parents and Staff:

Maricopa Unified School District promises safe, inviting, well-maintained schools that play a vital role in attracting new residents and enhancing property values. **We are on a mission to secure additional funding for repair and renewal projects without increasing local taxes.**

Over the past six years, the School Facilities Board (SFB) granted MUSD \$983,000 in Building Renewal Grants (BRGs). This year, however, MUSD is leaving no stone unturned and anticipates nearly \$2 million in BRGs in just a single year!

More than \$980,000 has already been awarded during the 2020-2021 school year for:

- Santa Rosa Elementary Roof Construction - \$434,845
- Saddleback Elementary Weatherization - \$210,353
- Pima Butte Elementary Exterior Weatherization - \$188,556
- Fire Suppression Pump - \$123,631
- Well Rehabilitation - \$28,439

The MUSD Governing Board and administration are committed to being good neighbors and growing pride in our community. We aggressively pursue BRGs to maintain attractive facilities bringing value to our neighborhoods without taking dollars away from the classroom.
