## COVID-19 COMMUNICATION

Dear MUSD Staff and Parents,

In the past week, we have responded to multiple confirmed cases of COVID-19.

Cases are being reported to us throughout the day and sometimes into the evening. As soon as a case is reported, school administrators contact students and staff who may have been in close contact with the affected individual. In addition to the personal contact, we send automated communication to the entire district.

We are committed to transparency, and it has been our practice to notify the entire district with every confirmed case. This means you could be receiving multiple contacts a day that do not directly impact you or your child. Beginning today, any general COVID notifications that do not specifically impact your child will be shared on the website only.

**If your child attends school for in-person learning, and needs to quarantine, you will receive an automated phone call with information about the quarantine. When feasible, school personnel will make personal contact to inform you about the need to quarantine and discuss the circumstances. Your child's teacher will communicate specific instructions regarding your child's distance learning plan during the quarantine.**

It is more important than ever to follow prevention protocols:

- Stay home if you are sick
- Properly wear your mask
- Wash your hands
