REOPENING SCHOOLS

Dear Maricopa Unified Employees and Families,

This week's update is arriving early as I'm sure many of you are preparing for the holiday weekend.

- Yesterday, Governor Ducey announced August 17, 2020, as the date on which schools will physically reopen for in-person learning.
- School districts have been authorized to start ahead of that date with 100% online/remote learning.
- The MUSD Governing Board will meet on July 8 to determine our start date for online instruction and learning.
- In preparation, MUSD is transitioning to a first-rate online/remote learning model that will deliver the curriculum and digital materials your children need to start the year strong.

Even though we plan to begin the year with 100% of students learning in an online/distance format, you still have the choice of models once students can return to in-person learning.

If you haven't selected your preference from the three models (Brick and Mortar, Remote/Digital, Hybrid Model), please do so. With this information, we may plan accordingly for the day when school buildings are once again open for students.
