We are energized by the downward trend in the spread of COVID-19. Governor Ducey released an Executive Order that rescinds the restrictions and mandates associated with minimizing the spread of COVID-19. However, this Executive Order does not apply to district and charter schools. Maricopa Unified School District continues to require face coverings.

Masks must be worn by all students, staff, contractors, and visitors while on school campuses, school buses, and while participating in school-associated activities.

Universal mask-wearing is one of the top mitigation strategies for safe in-person learning. Furthermore, the mask requirement is in compliance with the Arizona Department of Health Services Emergency Measure which is still in effect.
