In-Person Learning Reminder

As we prepare to reopen schools for In-Person learning, I want to clarify circumstances surrounding upcoming dates:

August 17

- By state mandate, certain ESS students begin in-person learning
- MUSD Community Preschool opens
- MUSD On-Site Learning Labs open for identified populations

September 8

This is the ***earliest*** date MUSD will reopen for In-Person learning. Reopening could be prolonged if county data does not support a safe reopening.

Attendance Procedures

Parents will no longer submit Distance Learning Logs for attendance purposes in Online/Distance learning. We have amended our Distance Learning Plan and, moving forward, teachers will take attendance through Google Meets or assignments submitted each day.
