After a careful review of the improved ADHS Benchmark Data released on September 3, the Maricopa Unified School District Governing Board voted to begin in-person learning by means of staggered start dates.

In-Person Learning Begins

- Elementary Students (Grades K-5) - September 14
- Secondary Students (Grades 6-12) - September 21

Families who have chosen to remain in the current online/distance learning model will do so through December 31.

New Teacher/Schedule Notification

Parents will receive notification directly from your child's school to inform you of any teacher or schedule changes that will take place because of the transition. Please watch for this communication during the coming weeks:

- Elementary School Students (Grades K-5) will be notified of teacher/schedule changes September 8-11.
- Secondary School Students (Grades 6-12) will be notified of teacher/schedule changes September 14-18.

Free On-Site Learning Labs
